TIPS FOR A SMOOTH START

- BEFORE start of project visit Architectural Review Section on GC webpage gladecrossinghoa.org
- Use online forms to submit plans to Architectural Committee.
- NOTE: There is a special form to be included with roof requests.
- Provide details. Include all relevant information -- plans, sketches
 or photos, dimensions and placement, colors (brands and names),
 materials being used, timeline, who will be doing the work, etc

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Failure to gain approval for project(s) could result in corrections, fines or both.

And the Fine Print



TRASH and RECYCLING CARTS must be set out by 6 AM on Service Days.

Remove carts from curb by morning after pickup. Hide from sight. (GC Covenants, Sect 4.14)

PARKING ON STREETS - Parking on both sides of the street can create blind spots and interfere with the safe passage of emergency vehicles. Please be mindful of where others are parked if parking on the street is unavoidable. THINK - Can a fire truck/squad get through easily? Seconds DO count!!

NO grass clippings or leaves in street or storm sewers. (Per BA City Code)

YARD WASTE - All yard waste is to be bagged. Limbs may be bundled. If bagged waste won't fit in trash cart, put it in either clear (approx. 30 gal) or paper Lawn Waste Bags.

PET OWNERS per BA City Code: PETS MAY NOT BE AT LARGE. PLEASE control habitual barking. Carry a bag so you can **SCOOP** the **POOP** in neighbors' yards and common areas!! **Tag pet** with contact info.

YARD MAINTENANCE - Neighborhood appearance is important to homebuyers as well as neighbors. Wellkept yards add to property values.

SIDEWALKS – **Keep SAFE FOR PASSAGE** by trimming overhanging trees and shrubs.

DID YOU KNOW? - BA Code requires parking of vehicles in same direction as normal flow of traffic.
